You will find that their 2002 Zinfandel is a really powerful wine, but the smooth flavors soften the edges making this a perfect wine for most foods. Its velvety layers of complex cherry, plum & pepper flavors unfold into a fully rich taste



From Temecula is a 2004 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon from the ever excellent Wilson Creek Winery. Its dark purple-ruby color prepares you for a full body wine with great intensity. Rich depth flavor and firm tannins makes it supple in its elegance and a wonderful finish. It will age well. Enjoy with red meats, especially steaks and roast beef.
